

GENUINE CRAFTSMANSHIP SINCE 1886

That the story of Tarkett should have its roots in Sweden – a land rich in forests – is not so strange. From it has sprung a passion for wood and the skills of transforming it for the basic human needs of housing, furniture and flooring.

From the beauty of nature to the hand of an expert, this know-how has passed from generation to generation of men and women at Tarkett ever since.



Tarkett's history began in the late 1880s in a small carpentry shop in Malmö, Sweden that created parquet planks from local oak and beech trees. Soon this thriving company introduced innovations like the Linderman board - a way of joining parquet strips together to make them easier to install, as well as multi-layer parquet that revolutionized the industry by counteracting the natural movement of wood due to humidity. It's a technique that still forms the basis for the European standard for parquet flooring.

This wood expertise helped drive expansion beyond Sweden in the 1950s to neighbouring markets across Europe by the late 1960s. By 1967, the company had become Tarkett with production still in Sweden – at Hanaskog.

Fastforward to today and the little carpentry workshop has become a major flooring group with manufacturing sites spread across the world. While production has been transformed by modern means, the fundamental knowledge and craftsmanship remain. In choosing Tarkett, you get much more than just a wooden floor. You gain an experience.





A majority of our wood is carefully selected from sustainable forests in Sweden and Finland. Sparse planting and slow growth in the northern hemisphere lead to strong and stable trees. We use the whole log, letting its grain and pattern form the design for beautiful, distinctive floors with natural warmth.

Wood species



OAK (*Quercus*) Highly valued and widely used for interior decoration due to its performance. The structure of oak is well recognized as both modern and traditional. A host of different patterns are possible, with designs ranging from calm to expressive. Lighter sapwood and knots enrich its different nuances from natural brown hues to carefully stained shades of the flooring.

Hardness 3,7 (typical values).
Colour change, oak matures and gets more golden.



ASH (*Fraxinus*) Thanks to its toughness and resilience, it is ideal for high strength applications. Strong contrast between dark heartwood and light sapwood often results in a lively pattern with rich variety of shades.

Hardness 4,0 (typical values).
Colour change, ash acquires a warm golden tone.



MAPLE (*Acer*) As one of the hardest light wood species, it is highly resistant to wear. Maple has calm and even shades. Its grain is straight with fine, even texture completed by curly growth rings.

Hardness 4,8 (typical values).
When exposed to sunlight, maple turns darker and golden.



BEECH (*Fagus*) is hard and durable. Due to its cell structure, movements in beech are stronger than in most other wood species. Uniform appearance and elegant warm yellow nuances are characteristic for beech.

Hardness 3,8 (typical values).
Colour change, beech will go from red to golden tones.



BIRCH (*Betula*) This Scandinavian wood is very light and has a calm tone with deep reflective lustre. It is slightly soft and is not recommended for busy areas. Variations in grain are barely visible.

Hardness 2,6 (typical values).
Colour change, birch turns darker and golden.



WALNUT (*Juglans*) has excellent wood working properties thanks to its softer characteristics. Its colour varies from light brown to a warm, dark-chocolate tone, with sapwood in creamy white. Walnut brings a strong character to the floor.

Hardness 3,2 (typical values).
Colour change, walnut's brown hue can become reddish over time.

Good to know

The common method for measuring hardness of different types of wood is known as the Brinell test. The higher the Brinell number, the harder and more resistant the wood is to indentation. The Brinell numbers quoted are average scores achieved over several tests. **Viva has a high Brinell number of 6, because the hard core of HDF absorbs the force of the Brinell ball.**

Wooden floors will change colour over time as the wood ages. Their shade is also affected by the ultraviolet rays of the sun. This can clearly be seen if you move furniture that has been standing on the floor for a long time.

Design guide

Wood is a living material and no two wooden floors are alike. Different parts of the tree will give the floor its unique character - calm, lively or expressive.

In addition to the wood species, many other factors affect floor colour, such as knots and the presence of sapwood.





Patterns



Surface effects

A brushed floor gives the wood's pattern greater emphasis. By using different brushing methods, the beautiful, natural structure of the wood is further enhanced. Adding saw or indentation marks lends the floor a more vintage look and feel. Flooring with these kinds of surface effects will also develop a more weathered-looking patina over time.




BRUSHED

Slight brushing to polish the wood pattern and bring out the contrast between the fibres, without going too deep.



DEEP BRUSHED

Semi-structural brushing that enhances the rustic aspect.



ANTIQUÉ BRUSHED

Structural brushing to achieve a relatively deep yet smooth surface, playing with the density of the timber and highlighting every natural detail.



PARTIAL SAW MARKS

A fully random effect where the depth and position of saw marks vary to create a very natural end result. The marks cover mainly the edges of the longer sides.



FULL SAW MARKS

Rustic, recycled design, thanks to sawing effects covering the entire width of the board.



INDENTATION MARKS

Camouflage effect ideal for absorbing wear and tear, as dents - a part of a floor's natural finish - will be highlighted.

Surface protections

When using your wooden floor, you primarily wear the surface treatment, not the wood itself. For this reason, a wooden floor needs good protection against wear, abrasion, scratches and stains if it is to retain its good looks for a long time. Wooden floors from Tarkett have Proteco, one of the strongest protections on the market. Proteco comes in three varieties which each will provide a different feeling to the floor.



PROTECO LACQUER

Semi-gloss lacquer is applied in six layers. Exactly the right amount of lacquer is applied – not too thick and not too thin – to make the floor extra hard-wearing.



PROTECO NATURA

Matt lacquer, which is applied in the same way as the semi-gloss lacquer, is just as hard-wearing and gives equally effective protection. It will retain the natural colour and feel of the wood, just like an oiled floor. It will require a little more care, as a matt surface always attracts more dirt than a semi-gloss lacquer.



PROTECO HARDWAX OIL

Hardwax oil contains oils from sunflowers, linen and soy. It provides a silky matt surface, reinforcing the feeling of the wood. The oil penetrates into the wood while the hardwax remains on the surface and provides extra wear protection. Like all other oiled wooden floors, it must be 'maintenance-oiled' every two or three years. It also requires somewhat more care than a lacquered floor.

Construction



A wood floor is a living, natural material that shrinks or swells depending on temperature and humidity. In zones with cold winters, we heat our homes, resulting in a dry indoor climate. This contracts the grain and the wood shrinks. The wood expands again in the spring. The changes in relative humidity can cause damage to wooden floors, which can crack or become warped. Tarkett has been making wood floors for more than 130 years and knows how to minimize these negative effects.

TAILORED MANUFACTURING PROCESS

We take into account the changes in the wood throughout the entire manufacturing cycle to minimize movement in the finished wood floor. An advanced drying process is essential to ensure high product quality and can sometimes take up to one year.

STABLE STRUCTURE

To minimize natural movements, our wooden floors are built up in three layers. By alternating the direction of the fibres in these layers, movements in the wood are minimized, creating a balanced, stable floor. Our strong glueless locking systems lock the boards tightly against one another without any gaps.




Underfloor heating for increased comfort


When installing wood flooring on heated subfloors, it is essential that the surface temperature never exceeds 27°C and that the chosen system provides equal heating throughout the entire floor surface, including rugged areas. Please also note that underfloor heating can cause gaps between the floorboards during winter. Some wood species and constructions are more prone to movement and are, therefore, not recommended for underfloor heating. For details, read our product datasheet on www.tarkett.com. All other types of wood are compatible if the instructions above are followed.




Different bevels



Beveling, either light or deep, emphasizes the overall plank design.





INSTALLATION

2-lock makes it easy and quick!

Using 2-lock makes it simpler than ever to lay wooden floors. The secret is a small spring in the end of each floorboard.

Pressing down locks the board to its neighbour. It's quick and the board stays put.

Follow the instructions and you can easily lay a floor in an average-sized room in less than a day.

Our super wide and large **Elegance** planks come with a tongue and groove system for a glue-down installation.

Our **Viva** ranges come with the Ultraloc installation system, optimal for renovation thanks to its horizontal connection.

1 BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Make sure the subfloor is level, firm, dry and clean. The climate in the room needs to be correct, relative humidity 30-60% and a minimum temperature of 18°C, before, during and after installation. You must not open the packs until immediately before installation.

If there is a box with a START & STOP label, it is highly recommended to begin the installation from this box which includes a board divided into two pieces. The first row should be started with the START part. The STOP part can be used at the end of a row and, if needed, cut to correct size.

2 SUBFLOOR PREPARATION

USE TARKETT UNDERLAY MATERIAL

For a floating installation - when the wooden floor is joined together without being attached to the subfloor - you should use an underlay material to level the surface, optimize sound performance and increase walking comfort. To ensure your floor lasts longer, use Tarkofoam II, Tarkoflex II or technically similar underlay.

REMEMBER THE VAPOUR BARRIER!

A vapour barrier is a polythene foil that prevents humidity migration from the sub-floor to the wood floor. It is applied over the entire subfloor and should be laid with an overlap of at least 200 mm. The underlay material Tarkoflex II also acts as a vapour barrier.

3 INSTALLATION PREPARATION

Decide the installation direction. Take a look at the way the light falls and the shape of the room. It's easier on the eye if the planks run in the same direction as the light. If the light falls in from several angles, follow the longest wall.

Open a few packages during installation to create a harmonious colour transition.

Expansion gaps must be planned along fixed points such as walls, thresholds, radiator pipes and stairs. There must be no contact between floors in different rooms unless the floor is glued down. Large areas of floor must be divided up into smaller areas with the use of expansion gaps. The gaps and transitions between different floors can easily be hidden using skirtings, mouldings and collars.

4 FINISH

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Care for your wooden floor

The feel of a new wood floor is something you'll want to keep as long as possible. That's why you should devote some care to your wooden floor. Tarkett offers a range of high-performance floor-care products to maintain the lustre of wooden floors for a long time.

DAILY CARE

For daily care, vacuuming or cleaning the wooden floor with a dry mop is recommended. The **Tarkett Wood Floor Care Kit** for lacquered floors is perfect for this. It has a comfortable design with a telescopic handle, a microfibre cloth and a velcro fastener. Sometimes you may need a little liquid to remove dirt and stains. But be careful not to use too much water. **Tarkett Wood Floor Spray Cleaner** for lacquered floors is easy to use on these occasions, and the floor also dries more quickly.

If you want to use both, we have the **Tarkett Spray Mop Kit** for lacquered floors with a refillable liquid container.

Bioclean for lacquered floors and **Bioclean** for hardwax oil floors: Lasting, effective and biologically degradable general cleaner, which can be used for regular cleaning.

SOLVING PROBLEMS

Don't worry if you drop a cup or get a scratch in your floor, Tarkett has several products for you to make spot repairs.

REPAIR BOX

Wax bars in different colours that can be mixed to obtain the perfect tone on deeper localized blemishes. Seal with repair lacquer.

REPAIR KIT

Should an accident happen, help is at hand. Our repair putty comes in a wide spectrum of colours. Seal with repair lacquer included in the kit.

OIL REPAIR KIT

Repair kit with oils, brushes and sanding papers that, together with a little time and effort, will make good scratches and blemishes in your hardwax oiled floors. Colour-matched to our oiled flooring range.

MAINTENANCE

Refresher for lacquered floors: Protects and strengthens the floor surface, also preventing micro-scratches.

Refresher for floors treated with hardwax oil: Keeps the floor fresh and strengthens the surface against wear thanks to the hardwax it contains. It can also be used for parts of the floor that are subject to heavier wear.

Very rustic floors with cracks and surface effects such as saw marks and indentation marks react more to variations in relative humidity. They shrink in dry indoor climates and expand when the humidity increases. In the first year, particularly in winter, these floors (like Heritage for example) need some extra care. To rejuvenate hardwax oiled floors, use Tarkett Refresher, which gets right into cracks and features, protecting the whole surface.

TIPS TO PROLONG THE BEAUTY OF YOUR FLOOR

Use furniture pads to minimize scratches. A rug for wiping feet in the hallway also stops dirt. Protective chair mats help prevent floor damage from chair castors.
